A handful of student terms

• *SSL – Stacjonarne Studia Licencjackie,* full-time Bachelor studies lasting three years and finishing in a Bachelor degree

• *SSM – Stacjonarne Studia Magisterskie,* full-time Master studies lasting two years and finishing in a Master degree

• *JSM – Jednolite Studia Magisterskie*, long-cycle day studies lasting five years and finishing in a Master degree

- RECTOR person in charge of the entire university
- DEAN person in charge of a particular faculty

• DEAN'S OFFICE – a place where you can receive assistance in all manner of student-related issues

- RECTOR'S HOURS no classes at the entire university
- DEAN'S HOURS no classes at a particular faculty
- STUDENT BOOK NUMBER your own book number

• ELECTRONIC STUDENT BOOK– where you get your electronic passes and grades for courses, available at the Student Portal

• *STAROSTA GRUPY* / GROUP REPRESENTATIVE – a person selected from among the students in a given group to represent them in all matters

- *PDW/WDW* elective subject / elective lecture
- *LEKTORAT* foreign language classes

• WEEK I and WEEK II – Some classes are held every two weeks, therefore such a division was adopted. Week I is always the week in which a semester starts, while week II is a week following the first week, and then they're used alternately.

- *WEJŚCIÓWKA* a type of a student test which might sometimes be unannounced
- *KOLOKWIUM* a previously scheduled student test

 \bullet SESSION – something which all students dread O , the time after a semester has ended in which exams are held

• *ZERÓWKA / ZERO TERM* – an optional exam, organised by a lecturer before the session, in which unsatisfactory grades are often not recorded

• EGZAMIN KOMISYJNY/ BOARD EXAM – if you don't pass a subject at the second attempt, you may apply to take a board exam, which requires justification

• SEMINAR – classes in which you prepare for writing your diploma paper and discuss the writing progress with your promotor

- PROMOTOR a person who helps as you write your diploma paper
- DZIEKANKA / DEAN'S LEAVE a break in studies granted by the Dean

• *NEPTUNALIA* – a student celebration, accompanied by various events organised by the UG

• *OTRZĘSINY* / STUDENT INITIATION – an event organised for first year students
