

Report on activities carried out by the
UG Plenipotentiary for Open Access to Scientific
Publications and Research Results in 2023



By implementing the Open Access Policy approved by the Senate of the University of Gdańsk on 28th of April 2022 (22/22), the following activities were carried out throughout 2023 in specific areas:

----- UG Knowledge Base/Repository/UG Scientific Journals Platform

- 1. Continuation of archiving and sharing in an open model the full texts of articles, monographs, chapters and other documents in the Knowledge Base repository. Deposition of achievements for the purposes of evaluating the quality of scientific achievements and employee evaluation.
- 2. UG Scientific Journals Platform which enables journals to publish articles in open access improved functionality (https://czasopisma.bg.ug.edu.pl/).

Currently, there are 42 scientific journals on the platform.

- 3. Implementation of projects that received funding in 2022 (continued in 2023) under the Ministry of Education and Science (MEiN) program "Development of scientific journals" (17 journals for a total amount of over PLN 790,000).
- 4. Implementation of OA publishing support programs co-financing of publication costs by MEiN for selected publishers:
 - Springer national license 12 approved articles
 - Elsevier 39 approved and 1 rejected article; granted amount: USD 97 731
 - ACS consortium license 11 approved articles
 - IOP consortium license 10 approved articles
 - Wiley 2 approved articles; granted amount: EUR 7 828

----- Legal acts

 Regulation No. 76/R/23 of the Rector of the University of Gdańsk of 25th May 2023 on the central system of recording and archiving the effects of scientific, research and teaching activities of employees, doctoral students and students of the University of Gdańsk.


69 applications received co-financing for the total amount of PLN 306 941.

----- UG Scientific Journals Development Program

In 2022 17 scientific journals of the University of Gdańsk Publishing House received financial support for a total amount of over **PLN 790,000.** In 2023 the projects were still being implemented.


Picture 1 Open Access Statistics in 2023


Picture 2 Share of OA articles in relation to the total number of articles published in a given year (Web of Science database, as of 15.01.2024)
